**Any member of staff may make a referral to Essex Children's Social Care Services directly.** If a referral has been made and the child's situation does not appear to be improving the staff member with concerns must press for reconsideration and further action. Concerns must always lead to help for the child at some point.

### **Agencies**

Referrals to the Local Children's Safeguarding Social Care Services and Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO) are managed in Essex by the Family Operations Hub who request the details of the child involved in the disclosure and issue a case number before referring it on to the relevant department and a case social worker.
