A full term's notice in writing on or before the first day of term is required before the withdrawal of a pupil; in default of such notice a full term's tuition fees must be paid. This basic agreement is set out in the school's prospectus and a parent's signature on the final confirmation form for each child confirms acceptance of this condition.

Private Instrument, Ballet, Drama and Tennis lessons are available for those pupils who would like them as an extra subject, please contact the Bursar concerning this. Tuition fees for these extra subjects are charged separately by the teacher concerned.

School fees may be paid by monthly direct debit through Premium Credit – for further details please contact The Bursar.
